ACTS OF PARLIAMENT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of Victoria, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of Victoria, the titles whereof are hereinafter set forth, that is to say:—

“An Act to regulate the Practice of the Legal Profession.”

“An Act to authorize the raising of Money for Railways and Irrigation Works.”

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twenty-third day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and in the fifty-fifth year of Her Majesty's reign.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Alberton and Ararat;

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 26TH DAYS OF NOVEMBER INSTANT,

to be observed as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, at Bendigo;\*

THURSDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Eaglehawk;

MONDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Portland;

THURSDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the South Riding of the Shire of Warrnambool;

FRIDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Ballarat;\*

WEDNESDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Loch.
