PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Avoca, and as a Bank Holiday at Echuca;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Port Fairy, and as a Bank Holiday at Drysdale and Port Fairy;

TUESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Bairnsdale, Walhalla, and Yarrawonga;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Kilmore and Lowan, and as a Bank Holiday at Elmore, Kilmore, Nhill, and Serviceton;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Hamilton;

THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Portarlington.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this fourteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and in the fifty-fourth year of Her Majesty's reign.
