## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the seventy-fifth section of the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1197), it is enacted that Part II, of the said Act shall have no force or effect until the Governor in Council shall make an Order declaring that such Part shall come into operation: Now therefore I, the Governor of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do hereby declare that Part II. of the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works Act 1890 aforesaid shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twenty-ninth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and in the fifty-fifth year of Her Majesty's reign.
