PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c. &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI, section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III, section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:

- as a Bank Holiday at Swan Hill; WEDNESDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Hamilton and the Shire of Minhamite, and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Mount Rouse; THURSDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Stawell and the Shire of Stawell, and as a Bank Holiday at Stawell; WEDNESDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Wangaratta, the United Shire of Beechworth, and the Shires of Bright, North Ovens, and Oxley, and as a Bank Holiday at Ararat and Echuca; FRIDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Korong; TUESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Shepparton and the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga; WEDNESDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Bank Holiday at Wedderburn; FRIDAY, THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Inglewood and the Shire of Maldon, and as a Bank Holiday at Natimuk and Rochester; WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Numurkah; THURSDAY, THE 5TH, AND TUESDAY, THE 10TH, DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Gordon and the North Riding of the Shire of Korong; FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the City of Bendigo; MONDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as a Bank Holiday at Numurkah; TUESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Central and Eastern Ridings of the Shire of Waranga; THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Rodney and Shepparton, and the Central and Eastern Ridings of the Shire of Waranga, and as a Bank Holiday at Tatura; THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
- as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Shepparton. WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
