PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part-VI., section 135), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder to be observed as Public Holidays at the respective places specified, that is to say:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 29TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAYS OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the City of Bendigo;

THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Belfast, and at Jamieson;

THURSDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Dandenong;

THURSDAY, THE 7TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 8TH DAYS OF DECEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Omeo;

WEDNESDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, at Geelong.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twenty-seventh day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, and in the fifty-seventh year of Her Majesty's reign.

FRIDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Omeo.
