BOROUGH OF HORSHAM WATERWORKS TRUST.—
RATING REGULATION FOR 1894.

THE Commissioners of the Borough of Horsham Waterworks Trust, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Water Act 1890*, do hereby make the following Regulation:—

1. For all land and tenements within the Borough of Horsham Waterworks Trust District the water rate for 1894 shall be One shilling in the pound on the amount of the municipal valuation of such land and tenement for the year 1893-4. The minimum rate to be charged shall be One pound upon all lands and tenements valued at or under Twenty pounds.

2. Such rate shall be due and payable half-yearly in advance on the 1st day of January and the 1st day of July, 1894.

3. All water sold by measure for domestic and other than domestic purposes shall be paid for quarterly, and the minimum quantity to be charged for shall be that which at One shilling per thousand gallons would be equal to one-fourth of the water rate payable in respect of the premises so supplied if supplied otherwise than through a meter.

All payments shall be payable at the offices of the Trust, Town Hall, Wilson-street, Horsham.
