PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable John Madden, LL.D., the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Colony of Victoria, and Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1830 (51 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I. the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday at Wallan Wallan;

THURSDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Berwick and Dandenong, and as a Bank Holiday at Wunghnu; FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Alberton, Port Albert, and Yarram Yarram;

SATURDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Minyip;

Wednesday, the 15th day of February instant,

to be observed as a Bank Hollday at Daylesford';

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday* and Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Sale;

FRIDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Creswick;

TURSDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Horsham;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Talbot*, and as a Bank Holiday at Shepparton;

to be observed as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Flemington and Kensington, and as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra;

FRIDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Nhill;

WEDNESDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maldon;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bet Bet. * For Races.
