PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable John Madden, LL.D., the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Colony of Victoria, and Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135), and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF MARCH INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Templestowe;

FRIDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Talbot and the West Riding of the Shire of Talbot, and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Creswick and at Allendale and Romsey;

Wednesday, the 29th day of March instant, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Warragul, and as a Bank Holiday at Drouin and Mooroopna;

WEDNESDAY, THE 29TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAYS OF MARCH INSTANT,

to be observed as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Majorca *;

THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Half Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Shire of Benalla,* and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Yea and at Portarlington;

TUESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF APRIL NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Victoria;

FRIDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF APRIL NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Corryong;

WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF APRIL NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Newstead;

FRIDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF APRIL NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout Victoria.
