#### PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

Wednesday, the 26th day of September instant,

as a Bank Holiday at Maryborough;

Wednesday, the 26th day of September instant, and Wednesday, the 24th day of October next, as Public Holidays throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Euroa;

WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 27TH DAYS OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Majorca; \* and as Public Half-holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Shire of Tullaroop; \*

THURSDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Devenish Riding of the Shire of Benalla;

FRIDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Horsham, the Shires of Wimmera and Wycheproof, and the Central Riding of the Shire of Korong, and as a Bank Holiday at Horsham and Wedderburn;

TUESDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Cobram, Katamatite, and Strathmerton;

WEDNESDAY, THE SRD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kara Kara and the North and North-East Ridings of the Shire of Wimmera; and as a Bank Holiday at Sheep Hills and Warracknabeal;

THURSDAY, THE 4TH, AND TUESDAY, THE 9TH DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Numurkah;

THURSDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Rushworth;

FRIDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Gordon, the North Riding of the Shire of Korong, the North Riding of the Shire of Kowree, and the South-west Riding of the Shire of Swan Hill;

TUESDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Wunghnu;

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Clunes.
