PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

THURSDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shires of Avon and Maffra;

TUESDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Southern Riding of the Shire of Tungamah, and as a Bank Holiday at St. James;

WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of East Loddon, and as a Bank Holiday at Lancefield;

THURSDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Bank Holiday at Euroa, Tungamah, and Violet Town;

WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Talbot and the Barnawartha Riding of the Shire of Yackandandah; and as a Bank Holiday at Chiltern, Maryborough, and Nhill;

WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH, DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Bet Bet;

Wednesday, the 17th day of October instant, and Friday, the 2nd day of November next, as Public Holidays throughout the Boroughs of Majorca and Maryborough;

FRIDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT.

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of North Ovens;

MONDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Stawell, and as a Bank Holiday at Stawell;

FRIDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Clunes.
