PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1830, (64 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1830 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Marong and Strathfieldsaye, and the West Riding of the Shire of Dunmunkle;

Wednesday, the 10th, and Thursday, the 11th, days of October instant,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Huntly;

TUESDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Huntly, and the Central and Western Ridings of the Shire of Waranga;

WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Carisbrook and Dunolly, and as a Bank Holiday at Avoca;

Wednesday, the 17th day of October instant, and Friday, the 2nd day of November next, as Public Holidays throughout the Shires of Avoca, Talbot, and Tullaroop;

THURSDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca;

FRIDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Wangaratta, the Shire of Oxley, the Mokoan and Central Ridings of the Shire of Benalla, and the Yackandandah Riding of the Shire of Yackandandah;

FRIDAY, THE 19TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH, DAYS OF OUTOBER INSTANT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Rutherglen;

TUESDAY, THE 23RD, AND FRIDAY, THE 26TH, DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as Bank Holidays at Kaniva;

WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maldon; and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Rutherglen, and at Maldon;

THURSDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Bank Holiday at Bacchus Marsh, Camperdown, Cobden, and Terang:

FRIDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF OUTOBER INSTANT,

as a Bank Holiday at Seymour;

WEDNESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT.

as a Bank Holiday at Allendale and Smeaton;

FRIDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT.

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Talbot and the Shire of Barrarbool.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this ninth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, and in the fifty-eighth year of Her Majesty's reign.
