PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Wangaratta;

FRIDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Goulburn and Seymour;

WEDNESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday at Ararat, and as a Bank Holiday at Castlemaine;

WEDNESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, AND THURSDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,
as Bank Holidays at Kingston;

THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,
as a Bank Holiday at Drysdale and Port Fairy;

TUESDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,
as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday throughout Victoria;*

THURSDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Tambo, and as a Bank Holiday at Allendale and Smeaton;

FRIDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,
as a Bank Holiday throughout Victoria;

WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of McIvor.
