PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

FRIDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Devenish and Mokoan Ridings of the Shire of Benalla;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,\* AND SATURDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Maryborough;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kyneton and at Seymour,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Nhill and St. Arnaud;

THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Katamatite;

FRIDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Corryong and Kyabram;

TUESDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Kaniva;

WEDNESDAY, THE 7TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 8TH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT,

as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Town of Warrnambool;

WEDNESDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the North-Western Riding of the Shire of McIvor,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Mooropna and Shepparton;

FRIDAY, THE 9TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 16TH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Yackandandah;

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kilmore;\*

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,  
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of McIvor.\*
