## PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bet Bet,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Swan Hill;

THURSDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Sale\*;

FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Alexandra;

THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

as a Bank Holiday at Bairnsdale;

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Alberton.\*
