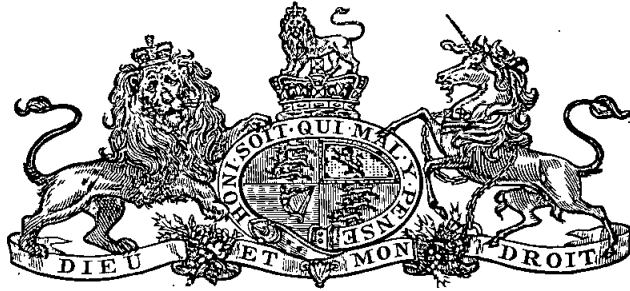

PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday at Birregurra,* and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra;

WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Bank Holiday at Wangaratta;

THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra*;

FRIDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Chiltern* and Mansfield, and as a Bank Holiday at Chiltern and Mansfield;

SATURDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Bank Holiday at Allendale and Walballa;

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday* and Bank Holiday at Violet Town, as a Public Holiday throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Euroa,* and as a Bank Holiday at Elmore;

THURSDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Sale, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Avon, and as a Bank Holiday at Warrnambool;

TUESDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF MAY NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kilmore.*
