SHIRE OF ALBERTON RE-SUBDIVIDED.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twenty-seventh day of May, 1896.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor.

WHEREAS by the Local Government Acts it is enacted that, subject to the provisions of the said Acts, the Governor in Council may from time to time make Orders exercising certain powers therein set forth, amongst others, to subdivide or re-subdivide any municipal district into any number of subdivisions not exceeding eight, and to determine and alter, within the limits prescribed by the said Acts, the number of councillors assigned to any municipality; and that every such Order shall be published in the Government Gazette, and shall take effect as from the day of such publication: And whereas a petition purporting to be signed by more than one-fourth of the ratepayers whose names are inscribed on the nunnicipal roll of the Shire of Alberton has been presented to the Governor in Council, the substance and prayer of which petition were published in the Government Gazette of the 24th day of April, 1896, and no counter petition received: Now therefore It is Excellency the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this present Order abolish all previous subdivisions of the Shire of Alberton aforesaid, and, in compliance with the prayer of the petition heroinbefore mentioned, doth hereby re-subdivide the said shire into three separate ridings, the names and boundaries of which shall be those severally hereunder set forth and described, and doth hereby further order that a council consisting of nine members be elected accordingly.

NORTH RIDING.

NORTH RIDING.

Commencing at a point on the Ninety Mile Beach, where the south boundary of the parish of Woodside abuts thereon; thence following the shire boundary north-easterly, westerly, and southerly to the Tarra River; thence easterly by that river to the south-east corner of the parish of Bulga; thence northerly by the west and easterly by the north boundaries of the parish of Wonwron and a line in continuation thereof to the northern boundary of the parish of Bruthen; thence easterly and south-easterly along the northern boundary of said parish to the southwest corner of the township of Woodside; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the parish of Woodside to the commencing point. mencing point.

CENTRAL RIDING.

Commencing at a point on the eastern houndary of the shire at the south-east angle of the parish of Woodside; thence by the southern boundary of said parish to the south-west angle of the township of Woodside; thence north by the western boundary of said township to its north-west angle; thence westerly by a No. 62.-MAY 29, 1896.-1.

road to the south-west angle of allotment 3; thence north by the eastern boundary and west by the north boundary of the township of Bruthen o the south-east angle of Buntine's pre-emptive right; thence north and north-westerly by the said pre-emptive right to its north-west angle; thence west by a direct line to the north-east angle of allotment 35, parish of Wonwron; thence west by the northern boundary and south by the western boundary of that parish to its intersection with the Tarra River; thence westerly by the said river to the western boundary of the shire; thence south-westerly by said shire boundary to its intersection with the Albert River; thence south-easterly by that river to the south-west angle of allotment 33, parish of Devon; thence easterly by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 80; thence north by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 81, parish of Yarram Yarram; thence easterly to the south-east angle of allotment 12, parish of Woranga; thence easterly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 11, parish of Woranga; thence easterly by a road through the parishes of Woranga and Tarra Tarra to the south-east angle of allotment 31c of the parish last named; thence north by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 329, a parish of Balloong; thence easterly by the south boundary of that allotment and Shoal Inlet to the eastern boundary of the shire; thence following the shire boundary north-easterly to the point of commencement.

SOUTH RIDING.

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the shire where it is intersected by the Albert River; thence southeasterly by that river to the south-west angle of allotment 93, parish of Devon; thence easterly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 80; thence north by a road to the south-west angle of allotment A17, parish of Yarram Yarram; thence easterly to the south-east angle of allotment 12, parish of Woranga; thence northerly by the Tarra River to the south-west angle of allotment 11; thence easterly by a road through the parishes of Woranga and Tarra Tarra to the south-east angle of allotment 31c of the parish last named; thence north by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 29a, parish of Balloong; thence easterly by the south boundary of that allotment and Shoal Inlet to the eastern boundary of the shire; thence following the shire boundary south-westerly, westerly, and northerly to the point of commencement.

Wherever the line described as aforexaid runs beside or along a river, creek, or road, whether specifically described or not, the centre of such river, creek, or road shall be taken to be the boundary line.

THE SHIRES OF BRIGHT AND YACKANDANDAH.
BOUNDARIES ADJUSTED AND RE-DEFINED.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twenty-seventh day of May, 1896.

WHEREAS by the Local Government Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1112), it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may make orders altering, for the purpose of adjustment, the boundaries of conterminous ununicipal districts or subdivisions without any petition: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Exemtive Council thereof, for the purpose of adjusting the conterminous boundaries of the Shires of Bright and Yackandandah, doth hereby cancel all previously defined boundaries of the said Shire of Bright and of the North Isiding thereof, and also of the said Shire of Yackandandah and of the Kiewa Riding thereof, and doth re-define the boundaries of the said shires and ridings respectively in the manner following, that is to say:—

SHIRE OF BRIGHT.

Shire of Bright.

Commencing at the junction of the Buffalo and Ovens Rivers; thence southerly by the former river to its source and south to the Great Dividing Range; thence southerly by that range and a direct line to the source of the Wonnangatta River; thence southeasterly by that river to a point due west of Mount. Birrogun: thence east by a line to that mount and northeasterly by that river to a point due west of Mount. Birrogun: thence east by a line to that mount and northeasterly by a range to the Great Dividing Range afcresaid; thence north-easterly by the range forming the watershed between the Kiewa and Big Rivers to Mount Bogong; thence northwesterly by the range forming the watershed between the Kiewa and Big Rivers to a point due east of the north-east angle of allotment 48, parish of Mullagong; thence west by a line to the north-east angle of said allotment; thence south by the east boundary and west by the south boundary of said allotment to its intersection with a road running through allotment 4 of XI; thence south-westerly and westerly by said road to the south-west angle of allotment 1 of XI; thence southerly by the sand boundary and west by the south boundary of said allotment to its south-west angle; thence north-east angle of allotment to the south-east angle of allotment 1 is thence south-westerly by the south boundary and morth by the south boundary and north-westerly by the south boundary and north-westerly by the south boundary and north by the west boundary and north-westerly by the south-boundary of said allotment 5, section 1, to the Running Creek; thence southerly by the south boundary and north by the west boundary of said pre-emptive right; to the south-east angle of allotment 2, section XV; thence westerly by the south boundary and north by the west boundary of said content to its south-wast angle; thence north-westerly by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 3; thence westerly by that creek to block 38, parish of Barwidge. Commencing at the source of the northern branch of the Twomile Creek; thence by a direct line northerly to the Ovens River
bridge: thence by the centre of the Buckland main road to the
north-west of Trapp's special allotment; thence by a line bearing
north to the northern boundary of the shire; thence following
the shire boundary northerly, easterly, southerly, and westerly
to Mount Hotham; thence northerly by a range forming the
western watershed of the Kiewa River to a point due east of the
German Creek; thence by a line and German Creek to its
junction with the Ovens River; thence by a line boaring westerly
to Dogherty's crossing, being a fording place so named on the
Bright and Morse's Creek road; thence by a direct line bearing
westerly to the point of commencement. westerly to the point of commencement.

SHIRE OF YACKANDANDAH.

Commencing at the junction of the Indigo Creek with the Murray River; thence easterly by the said river to the west boundary of the parish Belvoir West; thence southerly by that boundary to the north boundary of allorment 4 of section 11; thence south-easterly and south-westerly by a road bounding the said allotment and allotment 4 of section 10 to the north boundary of the parish of Woorragee North; thence south-easterly by the south-western boundary of allotments 1, 45, 15,

14, and 26A, section N*, parish of Woorragee North, easterly by a direct line to the south-west angle of allotment 28A, further easterly by that allotment, southerly by allotments 49 and 49A, and south-easterly by the northern boundaries of allotment 4 of section Can allotments 1 and 6 of section 28, parish of Baran duda, to the road from Beechworth to Wodonga; thence north-westerly by that road to the east angle of allotment 3, and north-westerly by that read to the east engle of allotment 3, and north-westerly by that river to the north boundary of the parish of Beethang; thence easterly by that boundary to the Mitta Mitta River; thence southerly by that river to a point in line with the east boundary of the Buggonia pre-emptive section; thence southerly by a line and a road to the south-east angle of the said section; thence easterly by the north boundary of the parish of Tangambalanga to the west boundary of the parish of Bolga; thence southerly and easterly by the west and south boundary of that parish to the summit of the range forming the watershed between the Mitta Mitta River and Sandy Creek; thence south-easterly and southerly by that range and the range forming the watershed between the Mitta Mitta River and Sandy Creek; thence south-easterly and southerly by that range and the range forming the watershed between the Mitta Mitta and Kiewa Rivers to a point due east of the north-east angle of allotment 48, parish of Mullagong; thence west by a line to the north-east angle of said allotment; thence south-westerly and westerly by said road to the south-west angle of allotment 19 to XI; thence south-west by a line to the north-east angle of allotment 19 to XI; thence south-west boundary of said allotment to its intersection with a road running through allotment 4 of XI; thence south-west angle of allotment 4, section XI, parish of Tawanga; thence southerly by said road to the south-west angle of allotment 19 to the north-east angle of allotment 2, section XIX, parish of Tawanga; thence southerly by that

Kiewa Riding.

Commencing at the Kiewa River where it is intersected by the northern boundary of the shire; thence south-easterly by the Kiewa River to its junction with the Yackandandah Creek; thence by a direct line southerly to the summit of the Murranurrangbong range; thence by the Murranurrangbong range and the ranges forming the western watershed of the Kiewa River to the western boundary of the shire; thence following the shire boundary southerly, easterly, northerly, and westerly to the shire boundary southerly, easterly, northerly, and westerly to the point of commencement.
