PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Colony of Victoria, and Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Hamilton, Portland, and Rutherglen, and the Shires of Chiltern, Dundas, Minhamite, Mount Rouse, and Portland;

THURSDAY, THE 15TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 16TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as Bank Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, at Hamilton;

FRIDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Shire of Castle Donington;

FRIDAY, THE 16TH, MONDAY, THE 20TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Dunmunkle;

TUESDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Natimuk;

WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Brighton and the Borough of Stawell; as a Bank Half-Holiday at Apsley and Brighton; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Dookie;

FRIDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of St. Arnaud and Wangaratta, the Shires of Bright, Geelong, and Wimmera, the United Shire of Beechworth, and the Southern Riding of the Shire of Tungamah; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Wangaratta.

FRIDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, AND THURSDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Benalla and North Ovens;

FRIDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, AND THURSDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Wycheproof;

MONDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at St. James;

TUESDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Devenish Riding of the Shire of Benalla;

TUESDAY, THE 27TH AND THURSDAY, THE 29TH DAYS OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, AND TUESDAY, THE 4TH, TUESDAY, THE 11TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 20TH DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Tungamah;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Let Bet, the North and South Ridings of the Shire of Charlton, the North Riding of the Shire of Korong, and the parishes of Laanecoorie, Shelbourne, Tarnagulla, and Woodstock, within the South Riding of the Shire of Marong; as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday at Korong Vale; and as a Bank Holiday at Wedderburn;

FRIDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Sheep Hills and Warracknabeal;

WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maldon and the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Maldon and St. Arnaud;

WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 7TH DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Karkaroc;

TUESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Nummuk;
