THE FEDERAL COUNCIL OF AUSTRALASIA.-PROROGATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the Act of the Imperial Parliament of the 48 and 49 Vict., cap. 60, intituled "An Act to constitute a Federal Council of Australasia," it is enacted that the Federal Council of Australasia shall be summoned and prorogued by the Governor of the Colony in which the Session shall be held, and shall be so summoned and prorogued by Proclamation published in the Government Gazette of each of the Colonies in the said Act referred to in respect to which the said Act is in operation: And whereas the present Session of the said Federal Council has been held at Melbourne, in the Colony of Victoria: And whereas it is expedient that the said Federal Council shall be prorogued: Now therefore I, the Right Houorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, in pursuance of the said Act, and by virtue of the power thereby cenferred upon me, do, by this my Proclamation, prorogue the said Federal Council accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this first day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, and in the sixty-second year of Her Majesty's reign.
