#### PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

#### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath;
Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1830 [54 Vict. No. 1133], in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1830 [64 Vict. No. 1164], and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1837 [61 Vict. No. 1534], I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and cates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively

FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Port Fairy;

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Omeo\* and the South Riding of the Shire of Borung;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of 'Avon and Omeo,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Mornington and Wodonga;

WEDNESDAY, THE 29TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Daylesford and the Shires of Mount Franklin and Woorayl;

THURSDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF APRIL NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Mansfield.\*

# CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE EXPORTED PRODUCTS ACT 1898 APPLIED TO BUTTER AND CHEESE.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the sixth day of March, 1899. PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor.

Sir George Turner

Mr. Foster.

WHEREAS by section 8 of the Exported Products Act 1898 (62 Vict. No. 1591) it is provided that the Governor in Council may by Order declare that from a date to be thereby fixed any one or more of the provisions contained in the said section shall be in force: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order declare that the whole of the provisions of section 8 of the Exported Products Act 1898 aforesaid shall come into and be in full force and operation in Victoria on and from the sixth day of March, 1899.

And the Honorable John William Taverner, Her Majesty's Minister of Agriculture for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
