PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Alberton;

MONDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT,
as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Birchip;

WEDNESDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,
as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Rochester and Rokewood;

WEDNESDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,
as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Yarram;

MONDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Moorabbin;

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Castlemaine, Chewton, and Queenscliff*, the Shire of Maldon, and the United Shire of Mount Alexander, as a Bank Holiday at Castlemaine, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Queenscliff;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Poowong and Jeetho and Seymour*;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Flemington and Kensington.
