PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey. Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Public Half-holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively

THURSDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT, throughout the Borough of Sale, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;* Wednesday, the 13th day of September next, throughout the Shires of Birchip, Donald, and Numurkah, and the East Riding of the Shire of Gordon;

THURSDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, throughout the United Shire of Beechworth and the Shires of Oxley, Wodonga, and Yackandandah;

Weinesday, the 20th day of September next, throughout the Borough of Echuca, the Shires of Birchip, Donald, Shepparton, and Tungamah, and the North Riding of the Shire of Violet Town;
Thursday, the 21st day of September next, throughout the Shire of Oxley;

WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Donald;

TGESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OGTOBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Numurkah;

TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Birchip;

WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Shepparton.
