PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the United Shire of Metcalfe, the Shire of Narracan, and the United Shire of Newham;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Balmoral Riding of the Shire of Wannon;

FRIDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Sebastopol; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Ballarat;

TUESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Winchelsea;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Broadford, Kilmore, Merriang, and Pyalong;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Portland and the Shire of Minhamite; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Colac;

FRIDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Alexandra;

TUESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Mansfield;

THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF NOVEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Ballan and Cranbourne;

THURSDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Lowan.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this thirteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, and in the sixty-third year of Her Majesty's reign.
