ACTS OF PARLIAMENT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of Victoria, the titles whereof are hereinafter set forth, that is to say:—

- "An Act to authorize the Shire of Preston to construct certain permanent Works and Undertakings in lieu of certain other permanent Works and Undertakings."
- "An Act to further amend the Land Acts."
- "An Act to sanction the acquisition by the State of certain land in the County of Dundas known as the Wando Vale Estate."
- "An Act to continue the *Vegetation Diseases Act 1896*."
- "An Act relating to certain general rules and orders made under the *Companies Act 1896*."
- "An Act to validate certain Licences and for other purposes."
- "An Act to amend the *Crimes Act 1891*."
- "An Act to authorize Contributions by Municipal Councils Banks and other Bodies towards Military Contingents for South Africa or any members thereof or their relatives."
- "An Act to amend the *Supreme Court Act 1890* with regard to the Boundaries of the Eastern and Central Balliwicks."
- "An Act relating to State School Teachers."
- "An Act authorizing the State to acquire certain Patent and other Rights relating to the Extraction of Gold and Silver by the Cyanide Process."

PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :-

- WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Strathfieldsaye ;
- FRIDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Talbot ;*
- WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the United Shire of Mount Alexander, as a Bank Holiday at Newstead, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Wangaratta ;
- THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Wycheproof ;
- FRIDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Mirboo, the Central and Tatong Ridings of the Shire of Benalla,* and the Corryong Riding of the Shire of Towong ;*
- WEDNESDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the City of Prahran, the Borough of Chewton, the United Shire of Mount Alexander, the Shire of Warragul, and the North Riding of the Shire of Dimboola,* and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Newstead, Warragul, and Yarrawonga ;
- THURSDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Mornington ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Buln Buln and Shepparton, and the North Riding of the Shire of Euroa, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Kerang and Shepparton ;
- THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Minhamite, Mount Rouse, and Portland, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Heyfield and Maffia ;
- SATURDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Benalla and the North-West Riding of the Shire of Marong ;
- MONDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bacchus Marsh ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Daylesford and Kew and the Shire of Shepparton.*
