### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c. &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions continued in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1899 (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 6TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 7TH, DAYS OF JUNE INSTANT, as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the City of Bendigo; \*

WEDNESDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF JUNE INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Avoca, Lexton, and Lillydale, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Lilydale.
