PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act. 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897 (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Maryborough; Wednesday, The 10th, and Thursday, The 11th days of October Next, as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the City of Randigo.
