Licensing Act 1890.

ALBERTON LICENSING DISTRICT.—DECLARATION BY RETURNING OFFICER.

I, THOMAS SMALLMAN, a Member of the Licensing Court for the Licensing District of Alberton, having been ordered by His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to take a Poll of the Electors in the Licensing District of Alberton, on the 29th day of November, A.D. 1901, to determine whether or not the number of Victuallers' Licences in the said District shall be increased, and the Honorable the Chief Secretary, the Minister for the time being administering the *Licensing Act 1890*, having, under the authority of clause 6 of the Regulations for taking a Poll of Electors under the provisions of section 30 of the said *Licensing Act 1890*, duly appointed Thomas Barton Wade, Clerk of Courts at Yarram Yarram, to be my substitute herein, do hereby declare that I and my substitute took such Poll accordingly, and that the determination of the said Electors is that the number of Victuallers' Licences in the said Licensing District shall be increased from the existing number three (3) to four (4).
