His Excellency may be expected to arrive at St. Kilda at half-past Two o'clock, and will land at the pier there. He will then proceed to the Exhibition Building.

PORTS IN VICTORIA.—ADDITIONAL REGULATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by Part II. of the *Marine Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1165) it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council, by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette*, may from time to time define the limits and boundaries of ports in Victoria, and frame rules and regulations for the governance and preservation of the said ports respectively, and for the regulation of shipping in the same, and also for the due protection and preservation and the good government and management of all public wharfs, and may appoint officers to carry out and enforce such rules and regulations; but that no rules or regulations made as aforesaid respecting any public wharf shall have any force or validity to repeal or affect any by-law passed by the corporation of the city of Melbourne or of the town of Geelong or by the council of any borough, district, or shire for preventing obstruction and encumbrances in and upon any wharf within the limits of such city, town, borough, district, or shire; and that any such limits, boundaries, rules, and regulations may from time to time be in like manner altered, amended, or repealed, and others substituted in their stead: Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do hereby make the following Additional Regulation for Ports in Victoria, that is to say:—

REGULATION OF TRAFFIC AT THE ST. KILDA PIER DURING THE LANDING OF HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR ON THE
10TH DECEMBER, 1901.

On the 10th December, 1901, no person shall cause or permit the landing of any passengers from excursion boats at the St. Kilda Pier, and such pier will be closed against all persons not having official business thereon.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this third day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and one, and in the first year of His Majesty's reign.
