PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it hath pleased Almighty God to call to His Mercy our Late Sovereign Lady Queen Victoria, of blessed and glorious memory, by whose decease the Imperial Crown of, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of all other of Her late Majesty's Dominions, is solely and rightfully come to the High and Mighty Prince Albert Edward: We, His Excellency the Honourable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria; the Right Honourable Sir George Turner, Privy Councillor, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Premier; the Honourable Sir William Austin Zeal, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, President of the Legislative Council; the Honourable Francis Conway Mason, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly; the Right Worshipful Samuel Gillott, Mayor of the City of Melbourne; therefore do now hereby, with one full voice and concert of tongue and heart, publish and proclaim that the High and Mighty Prince Albert Edward is now, by the death of our late Sovereign of happy and glorious memory, become our only lawful and rightful Liege Lord, Edward the Seventh, by the Grace of God, King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India, Supreme Lord in and over the State of Victoria, to whom we do acknowledge all faith and constant obedience, with all hearty and humble affection, beseeching God, by whom Kings and Queens do reign, to bless the Royal Prince Edward the Seventh with long and happy years to reign over us.
