#### PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

##### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

THURSDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra,\* and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Hamilton;

TUESDAY, THE 23RD, WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 25TH DAYS OF APRIL INSTANT, as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Town of Warrnambool;\*

WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Malvern and the South and West Ridings of the Shire of Huntly;\*

THURSDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Warrnambool;\*

FRIDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF APRIL INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Mansfield;

MONDAY, THE 6TH, THURSDAY, THE 9TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAYS OF MAY NEXT, as Public Holidays and Bank Holidays throughout the State of Victoria;

MONDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF MAY NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the City of Ballarat, the Town of Ballarat East, the Boroughs of Browns and Scarsdale, Buninyong, Clunes, Creswick, Sebastopol, Smythesdale, and Talbot, and the Shires of Ballan, Ballarat, Bungaree, Buninyong, Creswick, Granville, Lexton, Meredith, Ripon, and Talbot.
