## CASTLEMAINE AND BENDIGO WATER SUPPLY.

## AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS.

**H**IS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria in Council, in pursuance of and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Water Acts, has, by an Order made on the 10th day of June, 1902, approved of the substitution for sub-sections (i), (ii), and (iii) of Regulation No. 3 (approved on the 2nd June, 1896, and published in the *Government Gazette* of 5th June, 1896) of the following sub-sections (alteration to take effect from 1st July, 1902):—

- (i) On every house or tenement of £16 annual value and under, One pound per annum.
- (ii) On every house or tenement above the annual value of £16, a rate of Six pounds five shillings per centum on the amount of the valuation up to £300 inclusive; Four pounds per centum on the amount of the valuation in excess of £300 up to £700; and Three pounds per centum on the amount of valuation in excess of £700.
- (iii) On every shop not used as a domicile above the annual value of £16, a rate of Five pounds per centum on the amount of the valuation up to £300 inclusive; Two pounds ten shillings per centum on the amount of the valuation in excess of £300 up to £700; and One pound ten shillings per centum on the amount of the valuation in excess of £700.

**GEELONG WATER SUPPLY.  
AMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS.**

**N**OTICE is hereby given that the Board of Land and Works has, in pursuance to and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on such Board by the Water Acts, repealed sub-sections (i), (ii), and (iii) of section No. 2 of by-laws approved on the 14th day of February, 1896, and substituted in lieu thereof the following sub-sections. (Alterations to date from 1st July, 1902):—

- (i) On every house or tenement of £16 annual value and under, One pound per annum.
- (ii) On every house or tenement above the annual value of £16, a rate of Six pounds five shillings per centum on the amount of the valuation up to £100 inclusive; Five pounds per centum on the amount of the valuation in excess of £100 up to £300; Three pounds fifteen shillings per centum on the amount of the valuation in excess of £300 up to £500; and Three pounds per centum on the amount of the valuation in excess of £500.
- (iii) Buildings used for storage purposes only, such as bonded stores, shall be subject to a rate of Three pounds per centum on the amount of the valuation.
