THE Governor of the State of Victoria in the Common-wealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in His Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of the said State, the titles whereof are hereinafter set forth, that is to say :-

- "An Act to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue the sum of Forty-three thousand nine hundred and ninety-two pounds to the service of the year One thousand nine hundred and two and One thousand nine hundred and
- "An Act to confer c rtain powers upon the Council of Agricultural Education, the Trustees appointed under the Agricultural Colleges Act 1890, and the Municipality of Castle Donnington."
- "An Act relating to the Parliamentary Joint Library Com-
- "An Act to amend the Benalla Fire Brigade Station Land Act 1903."
