### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir George Sydenham Clarke, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Fellow of the Royal Society; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1830 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897 (61 Vict. No. 1534), I. the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as Bank Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, at the places respectively mentioned, that is to say:—

FRIDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1903, at Rupanyup; Wednesday, the 23rd day of September, 1903, at Ararat, Chiltern, Dookie, and Minyip;

THURSDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1903, at Swan Hill; FRIDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1903, at Swan Hill and Warracknabeal; TGESDAY, THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1903, at Beulah;

WEDNESDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1903, at Elmore; THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1903, at Yarrawonga; FRIDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1903, at Yarrawonga; FRIDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1903, at Dimboola and Jeparit;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1903, at Avoca.
