for a period of eight weeks from the 26th October, 1906, upon the following express conditions, that is to say :-

- 1. That no person or persons shall employ in the said factory or work-rooms more than six females for more than forty-eight hours in any one week, and that the said six females shall not be employed for more than fifty-seven hours in any one week, nor for more than three hours beyond the selform parting hours in any one day in the ordinary working hours in any one day, in preparing or manufacturing articles for trade
- 2. That every female so employed shall receive not less than Eight shillings per week for each week during which she works overtime, and, in addition, each wage-worker shall be paid for such overtime at the rate of time and a half; and each piece-worker shall be paid Threepence per hour for overtime in addition to ordinary earnings by
