VII. No. 1893), has this day, after consideration, refused the prayers of the petitions under the provisions of the Act aforesaid as hereinafter mentioned, that is to say:

Petition presented by certain Ratepayers of the Shire of Marong (notice of which was duly published in the Government Gazette of the 25th day of April, 1906), praying that the area therein described be severed from the Shire of Marong and annexed to the Shire of East it edden.

Petition presented by certain Ratepayers of the Shire of Wyndham (notice of which was duly published in the Government Gazette of the 18th day of October, 1905), praying that the area therein described be severed from the Shire of Wyndham and annexed to the Shire of Bacchus Marsh.

No. 1893), it is enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time make Orders exercising certain powers therein set forth, amongst others, to subdivide or re-subdivide any municipal district into any number of subdivisions not exceeding eight, and that every such Order shall be published in the Government Gazette, and shall take effect as from the day of such publication: And whereas a petition purporting to be signed by more than one-fourth of the ratepayers whose names are on the municipal roll of the Shire of Glenely has been presented to the Governor in Council, notice of which was published in the Government Gazette of the 7th day of March, 1906, and no counter petition received: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby re-subdivide the said shire into four separate ridings, to be named the South Riding, the Central Riding, No. 58.—May 31, 1906.—5744.
