IN THE COURT OF INDUSTRIAL APPEALS.

In the MATTER of the FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACTS and in the MATTER of the DETERMINATION dated the 12th day of June, 1907, of the SPECIAL BOARD appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of Breadmaking or Baking.

Friday, the 6th day of September, 1907.

THIS APPEAL coming on for hearing before this Court on the 26th, 27th, and 28th days of August last: Upon reading the Notice of Appeal herein dated the 15th day of August last, and upon hearing what was alleged in support of and in opposition to the said Appeal, this Court doth order and determine that the said Appeal be allowed, and that the Determination of the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of Breadmaking or Baking, dated the 12th day of June, 1907, be amended by fixing the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to persons engaged in Breadmaking or Baking at 1s. 0½d. per hour, or £2 10s. for a maximum number of 48 hours per week, but to foremen engaged in Breadmaking or Baking at 1s. 1½d. per hour, or £2 14s. for a maximum number of 48 hours per week. That paragraph 4 of the said Determination be amended by inserting therein the amount of £2 10s. in lieu of £2 14s., and that paragraph 5 of the said Determination be amended by inserting therein the amount of 1s. 0½d. in lieu of 1s. 1½d., and the amount of £2 10s. in lieu of £2 14s. This Determination to come into force on Saturday, the 14th day of September, 1907, at midnight.
