DETERMINATION OF THE SPECIAL BOARD

APPOINTED

TO DETERMINE THE LOWEST PRICES OR RATES WHICH MAY BE PAID TO ANY PERSON FOR WHOLLY OR PARTLY PREPARING OR MANUFACTURING, EITHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE A FACTORY OR WORK-ROOM, BOOTS, SHOES, AND SLIPPERS OF EVERY DESCRIPTION.

DETERMINATION OF THE SPECIAL BOARD APPOINTED TO DETERMINE THE LOWEST PRICES OR RATES WHICH MAY BE PAID TO ANY PERSON FOR WHOLLY OR PARTLY PREPARING OR MANUFACTURING, EITHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE A FACTORY OR WORK-ROOM, BOOTS, SHOES, AND SLIPPERS OF EVERY DESCRIPTION.

THE Board has fixed the 2nd December, 1907, as the date from which the following Determination of the Board shall come into force.

All previous Determinations of the Board fixing the lowest price or rate which may be paid to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing, either inside or outside a factory or work-room, boots, shoes, and slippers of every description shall, from and after the date upon which this present Determination comes into force and be operative, be cancelled and annulled:—

Hours.

That the maximum number of hours per week for which the lowest wages, price, or rates fixed by the Board shall be payable to all male employés over the age of sixteen years shall be 48 hours.

ADULT MALES. - WATES.

That the lowest rates of wages to be paid to adult males employed in wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing boots, shoes, and slippers of every description, either by hand or machinery, shall be—

MALE IMPROVERS .- NUMBER.

That the number of male improvers who may be employed within any factory or work-room shall be in the following proportion to journeymen engaged for the past nine months, except in the case of any person or persons commencing business, when the provision respecting the employment of journeymen for the past nine months shall not be enforced, that is to say:—

One male improver to every three, or fraction of three, journeymen.

MALE APPRENTICES OR IMPROVERS .- WAGES.

That the following shall be the lowest rates of wages to be paid to any male apprentice or improver employed in wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing boots, shoes, and slippers of every description, viz. :—

Females.—Wages.

That the lowest rate of wages to be paid to females, with five years' experience and over, employed in wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing boots, shoes, and slippers of every description shall be Twenty-one shillings per week of forty-eight hours.

FEMALE IMPROVERS .- NUMBER.

That the number of female improvers who may be employed within any factory or work-room shall be in the proportion of two female improvers to every female receiving not less than Twenty shillings per week or piece-work rate, employed for the past nine months, except in the case of any person or persons commencing business, when the provision respecting the employment of females for the past nine months shall not be enforced.

FEMALE APPRENTICES OR IMPROVERS .- WAGES.

That the following shall be the lowest rates of wages to be paid to female apprentices or improvers employed in wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing boots, shoes, and slippers of every description, viz.:—

GENERAL CONDITIONS.

Where females are employed making or finishing or clicking (but not skiving or trimming) insides or outsides, or stuff cutting by hand, they shall be paid at the same rates as males.

INSIDE WORKERS.

Employers shall supply all grindery, colours, and materials, and also find workshop room and light for inside workers, free of charge.

OUTSIDE WORKERS.

Employers shall supply all grindery, colours, and materials (except for wax-thread work) for outside workers, free of charge.

OVERTIME.

That the wages price or rate which shall be paid to any male employé over the age of sixteen years who works for any time in excess of forty-eight hours per week as fixed by the Board shall be Three-pence per hour in addition to the wages price or rate set forth in this Determination.

PIECE-WORK RATES.

That the lowest piece-work prices or rates shall be as follow:-

Outsides only, no skiving, toe-caps included; to apply to all lines except otherwise mentioned.
