FURTHER PROROGUING THE PARLIAMENT OF VICTORIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir Reginald Arthur James Talbot, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the fifth day of February, 1907: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the twelfth day of March, 1907.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this first day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seven, and in the seventh year of His Majesty's reign.
