LEVÉE.

Gentlemen attending the Levée are requested to appear in uniform, official dress, or morning costume, and to provide themselves with a card with their name legibly written or printed thereon, to be given to the Chamberlain, who will announce the name to Their Excellencies.

Gentlemen who have received cards for the Private Entrée are requested to assemble at the State Entrance at 11.45 a.m., and the other gentlemen at the Ball-room Entrance.

Members of the Corporation of the City, the Council and Senate of the University, Officers of the Navy and Army, and Public Bodies will enter by the Ball-room Entrance and assemble in the Annexe of the Ball-room in the positions allotted to them.
