DETERMINATION OF THE SADDLERY BOARD.

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Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SADDLERY BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of manufacturing harness, saddlery, and whipthongs has made the following determination, namely:—

That all previous determinations of the Saddlery Board be cancelled and annulled from and after the date upon which the present determination of the Board comes into force and is operative.

PART I.

HARNESS AND SADDLERY.

MALES.

WAGES.

- (a) That the lowest prices or rates payable to any person employed in the process, trade, or business of manufacturing harness or saddlery shall be at the rate of Twelvepence per hour, or Two pounds eight shillings for a maximum number of 48 hours per week.
- (b) Work not enumerated in piece-work prices or rates (other than that fixed for whipthongs) to be paid for at rates not less than that which will enable an average worker to earn Twelvepence per hour.

PROPORTION OF IMPROVERS.

That the number of male improvers who may be employed in a factory or work-room or shop or place manufacturing harness or saddlery shall be one improver to every three persons or fraction of three persons employed in manufacturing harness or saddlery, and receiving the minimum wage of Twelvepence per hour, or who are being paid piece-work rates.

That the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to male apprentices who may be employed in manufacturing harness or saddlery shall be as follows, namely:—

And thereafter either piece-work rates or at the rate of Twelvepence per hour, or $\pounds 2$ 8s. per week of 48 hours.

OVERTIME FOR MALES OVER SIXTEEN YEARS.

That the wages price or rate which shall be paid to any male person over the age of sixteen years who may be employed in manufacturing harness or saddlery for more than 48 hours per week shall be for such extra hours pro rata rates, and in addition the sum of 3d. per hour.

But if any female is engaged in hand stitching, preparing, creasing, edging or finishing any work not specified above she shall be paid at piece-work rates as fixed in the schedules to this determination.

PROPORTION OF FEMALE IMPROVERS.

That the number of female improvers who may be employed in a factory or work-room or shop or place manufacturing harness or saddlery shall be—
2 improvers to 1 female, receiving not less than 20s. per week of 48 hours,

- 4 improvers to 2 females, receiving not less than 20s. per week of 48 hours,
- 5 improvers to 3 females, receiving not less than 20s. per week of 48 hours,
- 6 improvers to 4 females receiving not less than 20s. per week of 48 hours,
- And thereafter 1 improver to each additional female receiving not less than 20s. per week of 48 hours.

Provided that where no adult female is employed in any factory or work-room or shop or place in which harness or saddlery is wholly or partly prepared or manufactured, one female improver may be employed where not less than three adult males are working.

RATE OF WAGES OF FEMALE APPRENTICES OR IMPROVERS.

That the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to female apprentices or improvers who may be employed in machine sewing or manufacturing harness or saddlery shall be as follows, namely :-

PJECE-WORK.

That the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing any article of the description referred to in the following schedules of rates, or for doing work of the kind specified in connexion with the preparation or manufacture of any such article, shall be the price or rate fixed for such article or work, as the case may be, subject to such extras or deductions as are provided by the said schedules.

Work to be taken as completed after passing foreman's inspection.

Material to be rough cut out and printed for workman, also web to be strained and hair and flock to be milled.

Material given out to be cut to length required.

Machine sewing to be done for workman, preparing for same to be done by workman.

Machine sewing to be tied off for workman.

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Where length is specified, increase or deduction in quantity of stitching, or stitching and finishing, to be according to scales on pages 12 and 13.

Materials—such as hemp, wax, jet, tallow, &c., to be found for workman free of charge by employer.

"Full price" shall mean the price fixed for an article without extras or deductions.
"Extra" or "extras" shall mean any work (not specified in the general description of an article),

the price of which is to be added to the full price.

"Deduction" or "deductions" shall mean any work the price of which can be deducted from the full price fixed for an article.

Where a lower price is stated for a specified quantity the materials for the whole number specified shall be given out at one time, and the full number shall be finished in one lot or the full single price shall be paid for each article.
