## SHIRE OF UPPER YARRA. PROPOSED RE-SUBDIVISION.

IN pursuance of the provisions of the *Local Government Act 1903* (No. 1893, section 46), the substance and prayer of a petition, in accordance with the 36th and 44th sections of the said Act, which has been presented to His Excellency the Governor in Council, are published, viz. :—

The petitioners purport to be at least one-fourth of the persons whose names are for the time being on the municipal roll of the Shire of Upper Yarra.

The petitioners state that the present subdivisions of the shire are inequitable and unjust, and that the ratepayers in the east and central ridings are deprived of proper representation according to their population and the amount of rates paid by them.

The petitioners therefore pray that His Excellency in Council may be pleased to re-subdivide the shire into three ridings in accordance with the altered boundaries as desired.
