Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SADDLERY BOARD.

IN accordance with the provision of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices of tates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of manufacturing harness; saddlery, and whipthongs has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That previous Determinations of this Board are hereby amended and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the third day of July, 1911.

The Determination and amendments are printed hereunder.

2. That the lowest prices or rates to be paid to the following persons employed in the process, trade, or business of manufacturing or repairing harness, saddlery, and whipthongs shall be as follows, that is to say:—

ADULTS.

WAGES.

- (a) All classes of scaming, handstitching or machine sewing all classes of work (except harness and black wax stitching, or quilting or crossbarring panels).
- (b) Hand stitching, cutting, preparing, creasing, edging, or finishing any work not specified in sub-clause (a)
- 6d. per hour, or £1 4s.

1s. 12d. per hour, or at full piece-work rates, as fixed in the Schedules to this Determination.

(a) That the number of male apprentices who may be employed in the said process, trade, or business, shall be one apprentice for every two or fraction of two workers engaged in said process, trade, or business, and receiving the minimum wage, or earning at piece-work rates not less than the minimum wage for adult males fixed by this Determination.

If within the times of beginning and ending work as specified in clause 5 of this Determination, any male person 16 years of age and upwards works beyond the maximum number of 48 hours per week, he shall be paid for the extra time so worked 31d. per hour, in addition to the minimum prices or rates.

SPECIAL RATE FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

That the special price or rate of payment payable to any person for all work done on-

(a) Sundays;

- (b) On the undermentioned public holidays, or such other day as may be observed as a public holiday in lieu thereof (that is to say) :-
 - (1) New Year's Day;
 - (2) The 26th day of January;
 - (3) Eight Hours Day, wherever locally observed as a public holiday;

 - (5) Eäster Monday;
 - (6) King's Birthday;
 - (7) Christmas Day; and
 - (8) Boxing Day,

shall be, for any male person over the age of 16 years, Is. per hour or fraction of an hour, in addition to the minimum prices or rates payable to him; and for any other person or classes of persons, double the prices or rates fixed by this Deterinination for such person or classes of persons.

PIECE-WORK.

That the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing any article of the description referred to in the six schedules of rates respectively of this Determination shall be the price or rate fixed for the article in the said schedules respectively, subject to such extras or deductions as are provided by the said schedules.

Work to be taken as completed after passing foreman's inspection.

Material for workman to be rough cut out and printed, also web to be strained and hair and flock to be milled.

Material given out to be cut to length required.

Machine sewing to be done for workman, preparing for same to be done by workman.

Machine sewing to be tied off for workman.

Where length is specified, increase or deduction in quantity of stitching, or stitching and finishing, to be according to scales on pages 12 and 13.

Materials—such as hemp, wax, jet, tallow, &c.—to be found for workman free of charge by employer. "Full price" shall mean the price fixed for an article without extras or deductions.

"Extra" or "extras" shall mean any work (not specified in the general description of an article), the price of which is to be added to the full price.

"Deduction" or "deductions" shall mean any work the price of which can be deducted from the full price fixed for an article.

Where a lower price is stated for a specified quantity the materials for the whole number specified shall be given out at one time, and the full number shall be finished in one lot or the full single price shall be paid for each article.

Piece-work not enumerated in said schedules to be fixed and paid for by the employer at rates not less than that which will enable an average worker to earn thirteenpence half-penny per hour.
