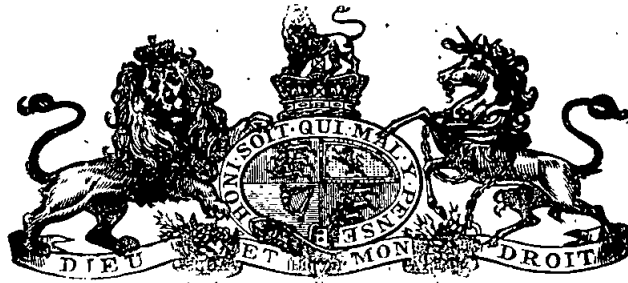

Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE BRUSHMAKERS BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a brushmaker, has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That previous Determinations of this Board are hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 27th day of May, 1912. The Determination and amendments are printed hereunder:

2. That the lowest rates of wages to be paid to the following shall be—

7. That the number of female apprentices shall be one apprentice to every three, or fraction of three, workers receiving the minimum wage of 21s. per week, or earning at piece-work rate not less than 21s. per week.

**FEMALE IMPROVERS.—NUMBER.**

8. That the number of female improvers shall be one improver to every three workers, or fraction of three workers, receiving either 21s. per week or full piece-work rates.

**FEMALE APPRENTICES OR IMPROVERS.—WAGES.**

9. That the lowest prices or rates payable to female apprentices shall be the following :—

For the 1st six months' experience,	5s.	per week of 48 hours
" 2nd "	"	7s. 6d. " "

and thereafter the minimum wage or full piece-work rates.

**OVERTIME.**

10. That any person who works in any week for any time in excess of 48 hours shall be paid for such extra time at *pro rata* rates, and, in addition, the sum of 1d. per hour.
