### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir John Michael Fleetwood Fuller. Baronet, Knight Commander of the Most
Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor of the State of Victoria and its
Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogned until Tuesday, the twenty-fourth day of June, 1913: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogne the said Parliament of Victoria until Wednesday, the second day of July, 1913, and I do hereby fix Wednesday, the second day of July, 1913, aforesaid, as the time for the commencement and holding of the next Session of the said Parliament of Victoria, for the despatch of business, at the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, in the State Parliament Houses, situate in the Carlton Gardens, in the City of Melbourne: And the Honorable the Members of the Legislative Conneil and the Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty first day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and in the fourth year of His Majesty's reign.
