ORDER RESCINDING ORDER IN COUNCIL PUBLISHED IN THE "GOVERNMENT GAZETTE" ON TUESDAY, 17TH NOVEMBER, 1914, FIXING THE PRICE OF WHEAT, POLLARD, BRAN, FLOUR, AND BREAD.

At an Executive Council held at State Parliament House, Melbourne, the 3rd day of December, 1914.

WHEREAS by an Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on Tuesday, November 17th, 1914, at page 5201, the Governor in Council on the report of the Prices Board appointed under the *Price of Goods Act 1914* under the powers in that behalf conferred upon him by section 7 of the said Act to fix the price or prices of the goods specified or referred to in the Schedule to the said Act did fix the highest selling price or prices for Wheat Pollard Bran Flour and Bread (being goods of the kinds specified or referred to in the said Schedule) : And whereas the said Board has by a further Report to the Governor in Council dated the 1st day of December now last past intimated for the reasons set out in the same that it considers that no good object can be attained by interfering longer with the free course of trade in connexion with the said goods referred to and accordingly recommends that the hereinbefore cited Order in Council be now repealed : And whereas by the said Act it is among other things provided that an Order in Council under the said section may be rescinded revoked amended or varied by an Order in Council made in accordance with a report of the said Board subsequent to an Order fixing the highest selling price of goods : Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, doth by this present Order rescind and revoke the hereinbefore referred to Order of Tuesday, November 17th, 1914, fixing the highest selling price or prices of Wheat Pollard Bran Flour and Bread.

And the Honorable Sir Alexander James Peacock, His Majesty's Treasurer for the State of Victoria shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
