Electric Light and Power Act 1896.

APPLICATION BY THE ASPENDALE, CHELSEA, AND CARRUM ELECTRIC SUPPLY COMPANY LIMITED FOR AN ORDER IN COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SAID COMPANY TO EXTEND ITS DISTRIBUTION MAINS TO SUPPLY ELECTRICITY IN THE SHIRE OF FRANKSTON.

(f) The applicants propose to take power by the said Order in Council to cross the Government railway line where necessary.
