Factories and Shops Act 1915.

DETERMINATION OF THE SPECIAL BOARD APPOINTED TO DETERMINE THE LOWEST PRICES OR RATES WHICH MAY BE PAID TO ANY PERSON FOR WHOLLY OR PARILY PREPARING OR MANUFACTURING, EITHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE A FACTORY OR WORK-ROOM, BOOTS, SHOES, AND SLIPPERS OF EVERY DESCRIPTION.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1915, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing, either inside or outside a factory or work-room, boots, shoes, and slippers of every description, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That previous Determinations of this Board are hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 9th day of October, 1916.

APPRENTICES AND IMPROVERS.

(3) "Apprentice" means any person under 21 years of age bound by indeutures of apprenticeship, or any person over 21 years of age who, with the sanction of the Minister, is bound by indentures of apprenticeship. (Act 2386, Section 5.)

The Boot Board has prescribed a form of apprenticeship agreement. Section 187 requires that the indentures must be in that form.

"Improver" means any person (other than an apprentice) who does not receive a piece-work price or a wages rate fixed by any Special Board for persons other than apprentices or improvers and who is not over 21 years of age, or who, being over 21 years of age, holds a licence from the Minister to be paid as an improver. (Act 2386, Section 5.)

OVERTIME.

(4) That the higher rate to be paid for any hour or fraction of an hour worked in any day in a factory before or after the ordinary working hours of a factory shall be-

First two hours Time and a quarter. Thereafter Time and a half.

SPECIAL RATES.

(5) That double time shall be the special rate for all work done on-

New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), Christmas Day, Boxing Day,

but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named Public Holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

INSIDE WORKERS.

(6) Employers shall supply all grindery, colours, and materials, and also find work-shop room and light for inside workers, free of charge.

OUTSIDE WORKERS.

(7) Employers shall supply all grindery, colours, and materials (except for wax-thread work) for workers, free of charge.

PIECE-WORK PRICES.

(8) That the lowest piece-work prices shall be as follow :-

CLICKING.

Outsides only, no skiving, toe-caps included; to apply to all lines except otherwise mentioned.

The Board determines, under the provisions of sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 144 of the Factories and Shops Act 1915, that any employer may fix and pay piece-work prices to any person employed at making cripple corks, provided that such employer shall base such piece-work prices on the earnings of an average worker working under like conditions, and such piece-work prices shall be fixed so that an average worker can earn not less than the wages rate fixed by the Board for such work.

DETERMINATION OF THE CARDBOARD BOX TRADE BOARD.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room in the process, trade, or business of a maker of cardboard boxes has made the following Determination, namely :-

1. That the previous Determinations of this Board are hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 16th day of October, 1916.

2. That the lowest rates of wages to be paid to the following persons shall be :-

APPRENTICES AND IMPROVERS.

DEFINITION (ACT 2650, SECTION 3).

"Apprentice" means any person under twenty-one years of age bound by indentures of apprenticeship, or any person over twenty-one years of age who, with the sanction of the Minister, is bound by indentures of apprenticeship.

"Improver" means any person (other than an apprentice) who does not receive a piece-work price or a wages rate fixed by any Special Board for persons other than apprentices or improvers, and who is not over twenty-one years of age, or who, being over twenty-one years of age, holds a licence from the Minister to be paid as an improver.

3. That the wages and number of apprentices or improvers who may be employed within any place shall be :-

4. That any employee who in any week works for any time in excess of 48 hours shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a third.

SUNDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

5. That double time shall be the special rate for all work done on-Sunday, New Year's Day,

26th January (Foundation Day),

21st April (Eight Hours Day),

Good Friday,

Easter Monday,

Christmas Day,

Boxing Day,

but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

PIECE-WORK PRICES.

(6) That the lowest piece-work prices payable to any person engaged in the following kinds of work shall be :--

Where rates are fixed for making boxes in parts, if any part or parts enumerated are not done by the person making the box, the amount provided for making such part or parts may be deducted from the complete price.

The rates fixed in this Schedule are for boxes made with glue, except where "made with paste" is specially mentioned.

If boxes provided for as being made with glue are made with paste, Is. per gross may be deducted

from complete price for making. Where paste and glue are mixed together in the manufacture of boxes, the rate fixed for making

boxes with glue must be paid Piece-work rates fixed for making uncovered, machine-made boxes do not include lidding and

nesting.

Any hox of the kinds enumerated in this Schedule not provided for shall be paid for according to the nearest size box of the same description, taking length, width, and depth.

Lids over 12 inches deep shall be paid for at Box Band rates.

Boxes fitted with calico, 61d. per gross extra; cleaning glass for lids, 1s. 11d. per gross extra.

Factories and Shops Act 1915.

DETERMINATION OF THE UNDERTAKERS BOARD.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1915, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons wheresoever employed in the business or occupation of an undertaker, has made the following Determination, namely:

1. That the previous Determination of this Board is hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 13th day of October, 1916.

The Determination and amendments are printed hereunder.

- 2. That the lowest rates of wages to be paid to the following persons shall be-
 - (a) Workers engaged in making coffins of oak, kauri, cedar,
 - white pine, or other wrought timber
 - (b) Workers engaged in making other coffins, trimming or
 - polishing coffins, or conducting funerals

 (c) Workers engaged in driving or grooming horses, driving or cleaning motors, washing vehicles, cleaning harness, doing general stable work, or placing the remains of
 - .. 56s. deceased persons in coffins

64s. per week of 48 hours.

Provided that workers who live at branch establishments and work for more than two days per week at the employer's principal place of business shall receive 20s. per week extra, and that workers who live and work at either principal or branch establishments shall receive 10s. per week extra.

* The hours fixed above for the week's work are to be taken as including time occupied in attending to horses on Sundays (not exceeding two hours).

APPRENTICES AND IMPROVERS.

3. The Undertakers Board has prescribed a form of apprenticeship agreement. Section 187 requires

that the indentures must be in that form.

"Apprentice" means any person under 21 years of age bound by indentures of apprenticeship or any person over 21 years of age who, with the sanction of the Minister, is bound by indentures of apprenticeship.

"Improver" means any person (other than an apprentice) who does not receive a piecework price or a wages rate fixed by any Special Board for persons other than apprentices or improvers, and who is not over 21 years of age, or who, being over 21 years of age, holds a licence from the Minister to be paid as an improver. (Act 2650, Section 3.)

(b) the proportionate number of apprentices and improvers who may be employed in any factory or place
