*Factories and Shops Act 1915.*

## DETERMINATION OF THE TINSMITHS BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the *Factories and Shops Act 1915*, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates of payment payable to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of preparing or manufacturing articles made of tin plate or other sheet metal, including the japanning of such articles, has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That previous Determinations of this Board are hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 26th day of October, 1916. The Determination and amendments are printed hereunder.

2. That the lowest rates of wages to be paid to the following persons shall be:—

## APPRENTICES AND IMPROVERS.

"Apprentice" means any person under 21 years of age bound by indentures of apprenticeship, or any person over 21 years of age who, with the sanction of the Minister, is bound by indentures of apprenticeship. (Act 2650, Section 3.)

The Tinsmiths Board has prescribed a form of apprenticeship agreement. Section 187 requires that the indentures must be in that form.

"Improver" means any person (other than an apprentice) who does not receive a piece-work price or a wages rate fixed by any Special Board for persons other than apprentices or improvers and who is not over 21 years of age or who being over 21 years of age holds a licence from the Minister to be paid as an improver. (Act 2650, Section 3.)

3. That the wages and number of apprentices or improvers who may be employed within any factory or place shall be—

## TIME OF BEGINNING AND ENDING WORK.

4. That the time of beginning and ending work shall be—

## OVERTIME.

5. That wherever overtime is worked it shall be paid for at the rates as hereunder:—

Between 12.15 p.m. and 2.15 p.m. on the day on which the half-holiday is observed ..	Time and a quarter.
Between 5.45 p.m. and 7.45 p.m. on the other working days ..	Time and a quarter.
At any other time outside the hours for beginning and ending work ..	Time and a half.
Within the hours fixed in clause 4 in excess of 48 hours in any week—

## SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

6. That double time shall be the special rate for all work done on—

Sundays,  
New Year's Day,  
Foundation Day (26th January),  
Good Friday,  
Easter Monday,  
Eight Hours Day (21st April),  
King's Birthday,  
Christmas Day,  
Boxing Day,

but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named public holidays the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

## PIECE-WORK.

7. (a) That the lowest piece-work price payable to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing any article described in the following Schedules (which Schedules shall form part of this Determination) shall be the price mentioned in such Schedules.

(b) That wherever the quantity to be given out is stated in the Schedules the prices apply only when the articles are given out in quantities not less than those mentioned in the Schedule.

(c) That the Schedules of prices apply to new material only.

(d) That (except where otherwise provided) where the sizes of articles to be made under these Schedules do not exactly correspond with the sizes stated in these Schedules then the price or rate fixed for the next nearest size shall apply; but where the size is half-way between two sizes then the next higher price or rate shall apply.



*Factories and Shops Act 1915.*

## DETERMINATION OF THE BILLPOSTERS BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the *Factories and Shops Act 1915*, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, business, or occupation of bill-posting, has made the following Determination, namely :—

1. That the previous Determination of this Board is hereby amended, and such amendments shall come into force and be operative on and after the 27th day of October, 1916. The Determination and amendments are printed hereunder.
2. That the lowest rates of wages to be paid to the following persons shall be :—  
Billposters . . . . . 56s. per week of 48 hours.

### APPRENTICES OR IMPROVERS.

“Apprentice” means any person under 21 years of age, bound by indentures of apprenticeship, or any person over 21 years of age who, with the sanction of the Minister, is bound by indentures of apprenticeship. (Act 2650, section 3.)

“Improver” means any person (other than an apprentice) who does not receive a piece-work price or a wages rate fixed by any Special Board for persons other than apprentices or improvers, and who is not over 21 years of age, or who, being over 21 years of age, holds a licence from the Minister to be paid as an improver. (Act 2650, section 3.)

3. That—  
(a) The lowest rates which may be paid to apprentices or improvers; and  
(b) The proportionate number of apprentices or improvers who may be employed by any employer

shall be as shown in the following table :—

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CASUAL LABOUR.

4. That any person employed for not more than 24 hours during any week shall be paid one and a half times the ordinary rate.

OVERTIME.

5. That any employee who works in any week for any time in excess of 48 hours shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a quarter.

SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

6. That double time shall be the special rate for all work done on—

Sunday,  
Good Friday,  
Easter Saturday,  
Easter Monday,  
New Year's Day,  
Foundation Day (26th January),  
Eight Hours Day (21st April),  
King's Birthday,  
Christmas Day,  
Boxing Day,

but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
