Factories and Shops Act 1915.

DETERMINATION OF THE WOOLLEN TRADE BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination, on the 6th January, 1919, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, and Geelong; the towns of Ballarat East and Warrnambool; the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, Castlemaine, and Sebastopol; and such portion of the Shire of Bungaree as is within 10 miles of a city, or town.

IN accordance with the provisions of the *Factories and Shops Act 1915*, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business carried on in a woollen mill, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 6th January, 1919, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
