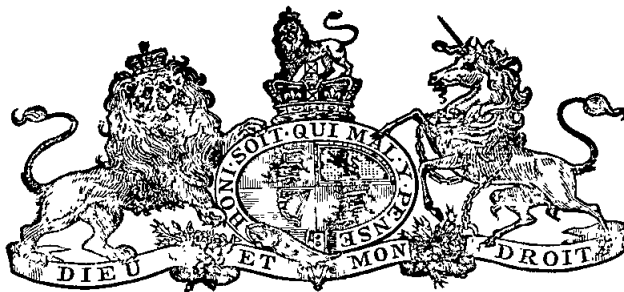

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir Arthur Lyulph Stanley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1915* (6 Geo. V. No. 2713), I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the day and date hereunder mentioned to be observed as a Public Half-Holiday at the place specified, viz. :—

Public Half-Holiday from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon:—
WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF JULY, 1918, throughout the Borough of Ararat.
