Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE COAL AND COKE BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 1st day of January, 1920, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act, the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in any business or occupation connected with the sale or distribution of coal or coke by any—

- (a) coal importer,(b) coal-mine owner,(c) gas company,

has made the following Determination, namely :-

(1) That on the 1st day of January, 1920, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
